### **MOVING TO A LOW CARBON ENERGY SYSTEM**

Finding ways to reduce emissions and look after our environment is a challenge for us all. # REUSE & RECYCLE IS HITTING THE MARK



There was great excitement during the cleaning process when this container was discovered having been returned for its tenth fill. After cleaning the old stickers are replaced and a new one placed on the container recording how many times it has been returned. "We set a target of 10 thinking that would be quite a challenge given what we had observed," said Rick Williams, McFall Fuel Lubricant Distribution Manager. "This really reinforces for us all that if every 20 litre container was treated with care rather than just thrown into landfill we would be really doing something for our environment. We also recycle those we cannot use. These are sent to Napier to be chipped and reprocessed."
