PIONEER CONFERENCE A GREAT SUCCESS

KEEPING FAMILIES WARMER IN WINTER WITH THE FIREWOOD PROJECT

Good Neighbour Trust is all about providing practical opportunities for people to support one another so that lives and neighbourhoods are changed. The charity which runs five departments covering food rescue, community gardens, projects like firewood and Whanau care is proudly supported by McFall Fuel.



The Firewood Project sees logs that are not suitable for export rescued from the Port of Tauranga. The volunteers cut, stack and dry the wood for the families who are referred by a local agency and then attend a firewood morning for just \$40, receiving two cubes of firewood for the winter. The families who want a load of firewood work with a volunteer driver to load the trailers ready for delivery. Further to this to keep their homes safe the local fire brigade sponsor the smoke alarms and then install them for free. Come the end of March 2021, 322 cubic metres of firewood had been delivered to those who participated in the project. New Zealand's heating is expensive and accounts for 30% of an average household budget.
