The programming and session content over the camp was spot on. I was very pleased to handle a higher training volume, whilst maintaining quality on the water. As you saw in Julia's summary, I had my biggest training week since Feb-

ruary 2022, and I was proud of this milestone. The feeling that I was training hard and managing the load, without having to adjust the plan meant a lot. "We will continue to follow Luuka's progress in the lead up to the world Champs – her work ethic and determination is inspiring. 
